LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

- 3. New library hours will go into effect on August 1. These will be: Monday Wednesday: 10 a.m. 7 p.m.

Thursday: 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. Friday: 1 p.m. – 4 p.m. Saturday: 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

- 4. Britni provided numbers for the Summer Reading Program. Considering the circumstances, registration was good. She will be surveying participants and other patrons concerning their thoughts on the on-line format.
- 5. Election Day has been declared a state holiday and therefore the library will be closed on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.
- 6. Britni explained the Cards for Kids Act which has been signed by Governor Pritzker. This prohibits a library from charging nonresident fees for the privilege and use of a library to a nonresident student in an unincorporated area in Illinois whose household income falls at or below the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Income Eligibility Guidelines.
- 7. Britni provided a color chart showing 2019 2020 Circulation. Numbers were good until March when the library was closed due to Covid19.
- 8. The new copy machine has been installed and is in use. Not all the functions have been activated at this time but Britni is working on the print and fax features.
